# Download and Install the Microsoft Authenticator Mobile App On Your Mobile Device

The following screenshots and steps are for iPhones. Androids will be similar.

If you already have the Microsoft Authenticator app installed on your mobile device, please open the app, add a new account, and proceed to step 16.

9. Go to the **app store** on your mobile device and search for the **Microsoft Authenticator** application and install it

10. Tap the **Authenticator** app on your mobile device to open it
