

# Pennsylvania Avenue Reconstruction



## OVERVIEW

Ramsey County, in cooperation with the City of St. Paul, is developing preliminary design concepts for the reconstruction of Pennsylvania Avenue between Rice Street and Mississippi Street.

The Pennsylvania Avenue Reconstruction Project aims to study existing conditions, engage the community, develop a future vision, and identify a preferred design layout for the corridor.

## GOALS

- Balance freight, vehicular and multimodal traffic needs by prioritizing safety, accessibility and convenience.
- Ensure transportation improvements benefit all segments of the population.
- Coordinate with local jurisdictions and agencies regarding ongoing, programmed and future projects.
- Identify a preferred design layout to move into final design for reconstruction in 2028 or 2029.

## TIMELINE

### WINTER/SPRING 2025

- Begin **community engagement** and encourage public input
- Analyze existing traffic conditions
- Begin preliminary concept development

### SUMMER 2025

- Continue connecting with the community on preliminary concepts
- Alternative analysis and evaluation

### FALL 2025/WINTER 2026

- Select preferred alternative
- Present alternative to community for input

### SPRING 2026

- Finalize preferred alternative

### 2028 or 2029

- Planned construction

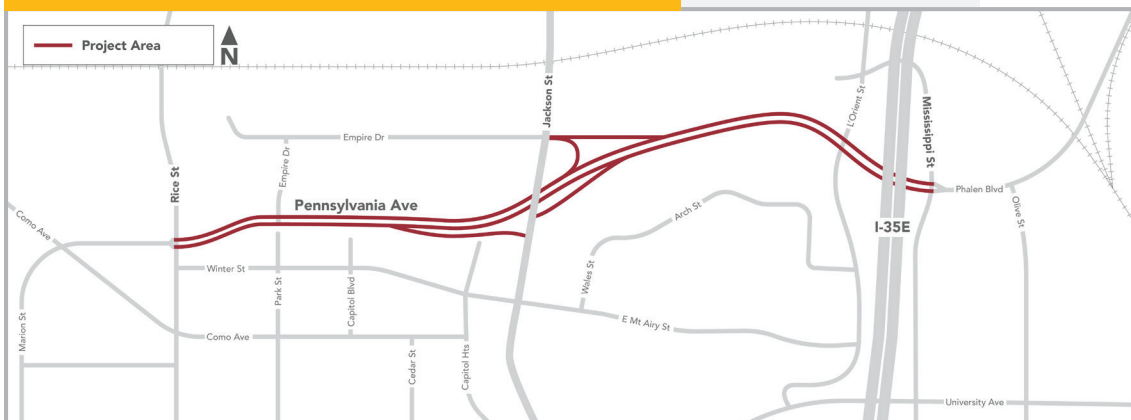
#### 2026
